If you are 65 years old or older and are current in the PLM Program, you qualify to be exempt from continuing education courses. The only class you would be required to take once every two years is the SFI Update course. We will send notices for these kind of classes and you can take it anytime within the two year qualification period. All you have to do is send us proof of age such as a copy of your driver's license.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

This class is intended for loggers seeking to become qualified Professional Logging Managers in the state of Mississippi. A qualified logging company, according to the SFI Standard, must have one person per logging crew hold this qualification in order to deliver to SFI Certified mills. Each crew leader or foreman as well as the owner needs to have these classes. Business owners in this program must begin by taking 4 required topics. Foreman need just this class. 3 of the 4 topics are covered during this class. The 4th topic is Business Management and will be held in June 2017. Remember: owners must complete all 4 core classes in order to be qualified and also get the Tax Permit for Professional Loggers.

The logger earning their PLM qualification must be the one to attend the classes. No one can take his/her place at the classes. You are welcome to have more than one person per crew go through the core classes and become qualified, but those individuals must be the ones to attend the classes. We noticed that a few loggers are still unsure of who has to attend the core classes and the continuing education classes. Each forest products company has their own rules about who on a logging crew has to be trained. Please check with whom you deliver to, to ensure you are following their requirements. As far as the PLM program is concerned, the hours you earn follow the individual, not the company. If your name is listed in the database, then you are the only one who can earn hours, no one can attend meetings for you to earn your credits.
